Item	task

3	The posters from the 25 th anniversary for the "New faces" session at the AGM in Tartu are updated on paper due to the fact that no electronic version is available. Katja will send the changes to Fiona to leave it open whether both posters or only one shall be shown in Tartu. The presentation for the new faces in Tartu is prepared.
4	The idea from the joint meeting of the SC and the TF chairs concerning "intercultural development of students" is discussed. The TF decides that it would be better as a staff training and not as a summerschool for students. Sabine will inform Ulle and Fiona about that.
5	The 2015 schools are discussed: July 5-11, 2015: LEF hosted by the University of Antwerp will focus on the fraternity issue; the school will host teachers from Aarhus, Bologna, Brno, Ljubljana and all members of the academic committee of the school. June 29-July 10, 2015: The Professional English Summer School will take place at the University of Hull. The program is intended for doctoral and postdoctoral candidates as well as newly appointed academic staff at UN institutions. The aim of the school is to increase the language
