Description or activity and the reason for the activity (including value added)

The activities involving research managers began with the AGM workshop in Krakow in 2014 which prompted the provision of the 'Research Funding Support' three day event in June 2015 hosted by the University of Utrecht. This was a very successful event which brought together a group of over 20 research managers from across the Utrecht Universities Network (UUN). It provided an excellent learning experience for those involved and one outcome of the event was the agreement that further opportunities should be developed (see section three below).

In addition, discussions amongst research managers have developed into the idea to form a new task force within the UUN for research managers. It is felt this would be an ideal way to address some of the key issues which are raised at the workshops and create real, ongoing opportunities for new international research collaborations.

The development of this task force has the potential to fill a 'gap' in the development of research managers across the UUN. Of

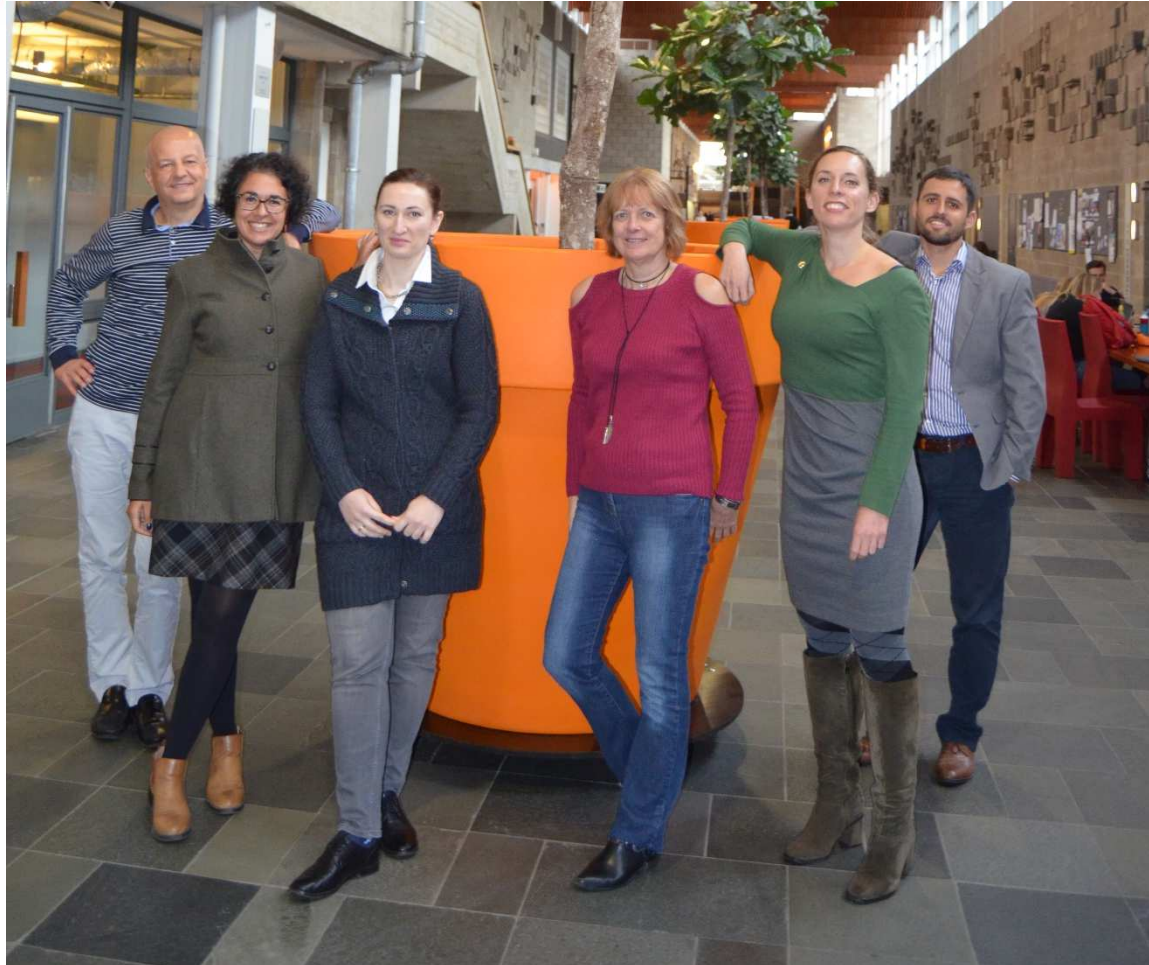
