Subject: 2 issues for the Steering Committee

Dear Alina, dear Raimonda,

Two issues to be discussed within the Steering Committee: (1) Erasmus Mundus Master in Advanced Spectroscopy in Chemistry and (2) Proposal of someone within the Network to be part of the working groups on the future of Erasmus+ (Commission request).

1. The Master Course ASC is coordinated by Lille and it is composed by Lille, Leipzig, Bologna, Cracow and Helsinki. It is a product of the old generation of the Utrecht Network reps, and now it is run by the new generation of chemists at the 5 UN Universities. UN has been an associated partner, represented by me. UN has contributed in the organization of the first winter school (I took part and I gave a session to students with a short presentation and an intercultural game) and, more tangible, UN has provided the hospitality

funds to the winter/spring school to students. They are considering to re-apply in February and they ask if they can confirm the participation of the UN as associated partner. Please consider it and let me know

2. I remember that the Commission sent an invitation to Networks to propose a name to be part of working groups to define the future of Erasmus+. In Geneva I briefly discussed this issue with Raimonda, approached by Francesca Maltauro from the DG EAC. We were considering to propose Anne to be part of the working group on KA1 Learning Mobility. I don't know if you have discussed and followed up on this. Of course you might consider to propose someone else, I just wanted to say that I think it is important for our visibility to come up with a name. I will be part of the working group discussing KA2 Cooperation (in National Agency quota). If we manage to have a name selected for Working group 1 as well we will have 2 "insiders" from the Network
