We are launching two new higher education working groups to discuss current and future topics on Erasmus+ student/staff mobility and cooperation projects:

- **“Making mobility a reality for all”** – Working Group I - key action 1 topics such as inclusion, digitalisation, simplification, recognition and traineeships.
- **“Cooperation projects”** – Working Group II - key action 2 topics such as monitoring content, developing clustering, disseminating and further exploiting outcomes, and impact.

In addition to National Agency representatives, we will also include people involved on a daily basis in implementing Erasmus+ mobility and managing, promoting and disseminating strategic partnerships.

Group members will cooperate closely on **how to better implement the programme and tackle emerging priority issues, both under the final years of Erasmus+ and in co-creating the new programme for 2020 and beyond.**

We would therefore like to invite you to nominate **a representative from one of your member institutions** that fits this profile. You should state:

- the person's name and the network she/he represents;
- their higher education institution;
- the working group you are nominating them for;
- a short description of their relevant experience on the topic.

Based on your suggestions, we will select representatives ensuring a geographical and gender balance. Please note that travel and accommodation costs related to participation in the meetings will need to be supported by the representative's organisation.

Working group I will first meet on 15 October, and working group II on 6 November.
