## Summer course: *Brazil Life and Culture*

The International Cooperation Office of Universidade Federal Fluminense will start, during the vacation period, a two-week course to present the Brazilian language and culture to foreign students. This free course aims to introduce international students to practical, day-to-day Portuguese language usage, as well as History, Geography, Music, Cinema and other cultural aspects of the country.

The course starts on July 29<sup>th</sup> and ends on August 9<sup>th</sup>. During the mornings, the students will have Portuguese language classes and, in the afternoons, lectures conducted by UFF teachers about the diverse cultural aspects presented above. On both Fridays of the course, the students will have guided tours to famous sites in the cities of Niterói and Rio de Janeiro.
